

The Board, as the governing body of the District, shall accept full responsibility for the general operation, management, and control of the District. In governing the District, the Board shall act in a policy-making capacity. It shall exercise executive, legislative, and judicial authority in order to promote the best interests of the District.

The Board shall retain the power to alter or veto the acts of any of its employees when such acts are deemed contrary to the legal policies or goals, or contrary to the legal obligations of the District, inconsistent with Board policies or goals, or contrary to the best interests of the District.
