

All meetings of the Board, Board committees, Board task forces, and other groups authorized by the Board shall be open to the public.

Upon the adoption of a formal motion, the Board may recess any meeting to a specified time for a closed executive session to discuss any of the following topics:

1. personnel matters of non-elected personnel;
2. consultation with an attorney for the Board that is deemed privileged in the attorney-client relationship;
3. matters relating to employer-employee negotiations, with or without the Board representatives;
4. matters relating to actions adversely or favorably affecting any student, except that any such student shall have the right to a public hearing if requested;
5. preliminary discussions relating to the acquisition of real property; and
6. matters relating to the security of the District's buildings, facilities, or information system.

Any motion to recess for the purpose of holding a closed executive session shall state the following:

1. the justification for closing the meeting;
2. the subjects to be discussed during the closed executive session; and
3. the time and place at which the open meeting will resume.

That motion shall be stated in the minutes of the Board meeting. No binding action shall be taken by the Board during any closed executive session.
