

The Board believes that parent involvement is an important part of the educational program. The Board will attempt to foster positive relationships with parents. Together, parents and the District will work toward achieving common educational goals for students, resulting in higher student achievement and greater community satisfaction with the District.

The Superintendent shall develop, implement, and maintain programs for active parent involvement in the District and its individual schools.

The programs shall do the following:

1. Provide opportunities for parents to be informed about their child's development and the criteria for its measurement
2. Help parents understand the educational process and their role in advocating for their student.
3. Provide appropriate resources to support parents
4. Encourage parents to share in school planning through the School-Based Leadership Councils
5. Encourage the maintenance of formal parent organizations at each school as well as at the District level
6. Encourage staff to support parent volunteers
