

The Superintendent may deny access to District facilities and their grounds or to District-sponsored events to any persons who are not District personnel or registered students and who have no lawful business or educational functions to pursue at the facility or event. Administrative personnel or their designees may demand identification and evidence of qualification for access from anyone desiring to enter the facility or event.

Any persons, including parents, who have legitimate reasons for being on District property or attending District-sponsored events must, nevertheless, abide by Board policies and administrative guidelines and procedures.

Anyone who fails to leave District facilities or events after being requested to do so by an authorized employee of the District shall be subject to charge and arrest.
