

The Blue Valley School District shall comply with federal legislation for the *No Child Left Behind Act of 2001* through administrative guidelines for the following items:

- ACCREDITATION OF SCHOOLS including the implementation of the Quality Performance Accreditation process
- EDUCATIONAL CURRICULUM including alignment with Kansas Curricular Standards
- COMMUNITY ACCESS TO SCHOOL FACILITIES including the adoption of a “limited open forum” and the notification of this decision to the community
- EMPLOYEE LIABILITY including the legal protections of employees and the restrictions on these rights
- MILITARY ACCESS TO STUDENTS including parent notification and permission forms for restricting release of student directory information
- RELIGION IN SCHOOLS including teacher, parent and student awareness of the rights of students in schools
- RESPONSIBILITIES REGARDING HOMELESS STUDENTS including the rights of students in schools
- RESPONSIBILITIES REGARDING TITLE I STUDENTS including the notification of parents and the written parental involvement policy
- RESPONSIBILITIES REGARDING LIMITED-ENGLISH PROFICIENT STUDENTS including the notification of parents and the written parental involvement policy
- STUDENT PRIVACY including parent notification of research surveys, administration of health and physical screenings, rights to review curriculum materials and survey instruments
