LEGAL REFERENCE: KSA 72-1107

A general explanation of the law follows:

*Kindergarten*

A child who is a resident of this District may attend kindergarten if:

- a. The child has attained the age of five years on or before the thirty-first day of August of the school year in question, or
- b. The child, regardless of age, was a resident of another state and, while residing in that state, entered and was in attendance in an accredited kindergarten in such state.

*Grades 1-5*

A child who is a resident of this District may attend the elementary grades 1-5 if:

- a. The child has attained the age of six years on or before the thirty-first day of August of the school year in question,
- b. The child, regardless of age, attended kindergarten while residing in another state and completed kindergarten in this state after establishing residency in Kansas,
- c. The child, regardless of age, was a resident of another state and, while residing in that state, completed a kindergarten course maintained by a public school district or by an accredited private, denominational or parochial school, or
- d. The child, regardless of age, was a resident of another state and, while residing in that state, had entered and was in attendance in an elementary grade 1-5 in such state.
