

1. The District shall not accept non-resident students except as defined in Policy #3111—*Residency Requirements*. The Superintendent is authorized to make exception due to extraordinary circumstances.
2. If any adult with whom a student permanently resides is in the process of moving into or out of this District, temporary enrollment of the student on a non-resident, non-tuition basis shall be permitted for a period of time not to exceed one semester, unless otherwise authorized by the Superintendent. Verification of residency may be required.
3. A non-resident twelfth grade student may apply to the Superintendent to attend the high school that he or she attended in the eleventh grade. As used in this policy, “twelfth grade” begins upon completion of the last day of school of the eleventh grade.
