

Except as specifically provided by law or in this policy, the District shall not accept any responsibility for the supervision and safety of students traveling to and from school. Transportation for students with disabilities shall be provided when it is needed to enable the student to have access to special education services and is included in the student's Individual Education Plan (IEP). The means for such transportation shall be determined by the superintendent, based upon a recommendation from the multi-disciplinary school team, and shall be provided in the most cost-effective manner possible. The District shall not transport a student with a disability outside the District unless specifically required by the student's IEP.

**LEGAL REFERENCE:** State law provides that the Board of any school district may provide or furnish transportation for students to or from any school of the school district.

The District is required by law to provide free transportation for every student who resides in the school district and who attends any of grades kindergarten through 12 if: The student resides 2.5 miles or more from the school building attended, measured along the shortest distance traveled by road according to state guidelines; and the student observes the rules and regulations adopted by the Board to govern the conduct of all students while being transported.
