

The Board of Education annually shall approve a calendar that will show the beginning and ending dates of school, legal and local holidays, number of teaching days, vacation periods and other pertinent dates. The calendar will normally be approved in January. The calendar will have a timeframe of two years out from the current school year.

In accordance with state statutes, students in the Blue Valley School District will attend school not less than 1,116 hours for grades 1 through 11, and not less than 1,086 hours for students in grade 12.

The Superintendent shall develop guidelines for the development of the school calendar that will meet the requirements of applicable laws as well as serve the needs of the community, students and staff of the district.
